

Sponsored Tournament Event Guidelines for Walleye Searchers

The following items shall be taken into consideration in the event an opportunity is made available to allow Walleye Searcher members to enter a sponsored fishing tournament.

1. The Walleye Searchers final point standings from the previous year shall be used to determine priority to enter the tournament. The point's leader shall have the first opportunity to fish the event, if that person does not want to fish the event the opportunity will be given to the 2nd place leader and shall continue until the positions have been filled.
2. The member that qualifies to fish a Sponsored Tournament Event shall be able to choose a partner of their choice. The partner must be a member in good standing and must have participated in at least one monthly Walleye Searchers event.
3. The member with first priority will be responsible for all communications necessary to obtain a future spot for Walleye Searchers members in future events.
4. Any member that participates in a Sponsored Tournament Event shall not have first priority the following year regardless of their points standings.
5. If Walleye Searchers is offered an opportunity to fish a Tournament Sponsored Event, the members may hold a special meeting to determine who will be filling to available entries. This will allow the member to make travel arrangements as quickly as possible.
6. It's the members responsibility to pay for all entry fees and expenses to fish a Sponsored Tournament Event.
7. If a member of Walleye Searchers would like to fish a Tournament Sponsored Event and he is unable to find another Walleye Searchers member for a partner, they shall be able to go outside of the club to find a partner. The new member must join Walleye Searchers and pay the full dues for that year.
8. Walleye Searchers encourages full participation for all days of the events. We will also display the highest level of sportsmanship while fishing.
